# Matching the Van to Your Life.

Not all adventure looks the same. The right van depends not on which specification impresses you most on paper, but on how you actually intend to live in it. Here are the four travel profiles we see most often, and which Remote Van fits each.



### The Weekend Warrior

You love having the option to escape, even if you are not on the road full-time. You want something nimble, easy to park, and ready to go at a moment's notice: national parks, long weekends, and the occasional two-week trip.

- T-45 at \$174,900: the most accessible entry point, full amenities, compact footprint
- Friday at \$194,900: adds upgraded power, Starlink Mini, and the Cyber Shower recirculation feature

### The Seasonal Traveler

You are on the road three to five months per year: summers in the Rockies, winters in the Southwest. You need a serious off-grid power system, a comfortable sleeping setup for two, and enough storage to live well for weeks at a time.

- Oasis at \$224,900: the most popular Series for couples on extended trips
- Purpose-built with Alpine sound, dual-blower climate control, upgraded suspension, and dual touchscreens



### The Full-Timer

This is home. You have sold or are planning to sell the house, and you need a van that delivers across every dimension: power, climate control, workspace, and the kind of build quality that holds up for 100,000 miles.

## CHAPTER 5

# Your Questions, Answered.

Before visiting a dealer, it helps to have the fundamentals in place. Here are the questions people ask most often about Remote Vans, answered plainly.



### How many people can sleep in a Remote Van?

Up to four. The queen-sized Legless Bed System comfortably sleeps two adults, and the Vanhalla rotating swing seat converts to accommodate two smaller children. It is a setup that works equally well for retiring couples and young families, without the van ever feeling cramped.



### What is the power system?

All Remote Vans are fitted with the MoPoWa Power System: a proprietary, fully integrated setup designed to be the most efficient in any Class B van. It supports three charging methods: shore power via the supplied cable, rapid recharge via the low-idle alternator generator, and roof-mounted solar for true off-grid power. Combined with our premium insulation and high-performance air conditioning, the result is genuine self-sufficiency wherever the road takes you.



### Is the water system built for off-grid use?

Every Remote Van includes the MoPoWa Water System, featuring a 30-gallon fresh water tank and a heated 24-gallon grey tank for complete off-grid capability. Plumbing throughout uses superior PEX-A with compression and brass fittings: chosen for long-term reliability, not cost-cutting. You can camp freely without hookups, whether you are at a remote national park or somewhere entirely off the grid.



### Can I live in a Remote Van full time?

Many owners do. The combination of the MoPoWa Power and Water Systems, Starlink connectivity, full climate control, and generous storage makes a Remote Van genuinely liveable for extended periods. Whether you are a retiree spending months exploring the country or a family on an extended sabbatical, the van is built to keep you comfortable, connected, and self-sufficient.



### Do you allow me to customize or personalise my van?

Yes. While every van comes as a fully specified, ready-to-go vehicle, you can personalise the look through our branding kit. This covers exterior and interior accent colours throughout: kitchen drawer fronts, water and power box panels, cabinet inlays, and the mounts for the Pennyworth Van Control System.

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## CHAPTER 6

# The 7 Questions to Ask Any Dealer.

You are about to make a significant investment. Walk into any dealership, including ours, with these seven questions ready. A great dealer will answer all of them clearly, without hesitation.

### 1. What does the warranty actually cover, and for how long?

Ask specifically about the chassis, the conversion components, appliances, and electrical systems. Find out what the claims process looks like and who handles warranty work in your region.

### 2. What's the real off-grid capability?

Ask how long the van can run air conditioning, the refrigerator, and all systems without plugging in or running the engine. Get specific numbers in amp-hours, not marketing language.

### 3. How does the solar and battery system work?

Understand the battery bank size (lithium vs. AGM), solar panel wattage, and whether the system has a built-in generator backup. Ask what happens if a component fails in the field.

### 4. What's included in the price, and what's an upgrade?

Get an itemized breakdown. Remote Vans uses see-through pricing, meaning the listed price is the best price with no negotiations. Other brands may have a long list of optional features that add up fast.

### 5. Who services the van, and where?

Ask about the service network. Can you get warranty work done across the country, or only at the selling dealer? For a vehicle you'll drive 15,000+ miles a year, this matters.

### 6. Can I see real owner reviews, not just marketing materials?

Ask for contact with current owners, or to see unfiltered reviews. A brand confident in their product will have no hesitation here. You can check out our owners group on Facebook: The Rolling Nomads.

### 7. What happens if I need help on the road?

Find out what roadside assistance, emergency support, or remote troubleshooting looks like. Knowing you have backup gives you the confidence to go farther.

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# CHAPTER 7

## Making it Work Financially.

A Remote Van is a significant investment. It is also, for most owners, one of the most financially rational decisions they make in the years leading into retirement, once you understand how RV financing works and what the van actually replaces in your budget.

### RV Financing Is Different

Unlike a car loan, RV loans can extend to 20 years or more. This changes the monthly payment picture substantially. At current rates, a 20-year term on the Oasis at \$224,900 with 10% down works out to approximately \$1,570 per month, which is less than many owners were spending on hotels, flights, and rental cars during an average month of travel.

RV loan interest may also be tax-deductible as a second home mortgage. Your tax advisor can confirm what applies to your specific situation.



### The Real Comparison

The honest financial case for a Remote Van is not about the purchase price in isolation. It is about what it replaces. A couple travelling for four months per year, at a conservative \$180 per night in hotels, plus flights, rental cars, and dining out, reaches \$20,000 to \$30,000 in annual travel expenditure without difficulty.

Most Remote Vans owners report that their total travel spending either holds steady or decreases in the first year. When home travels with you, spontaneous road trips cost almost nothing.
